## BECOME A GRANT APPLICATION REVIEWER



Based on their experience and interest, St. Louis City and County residents who nominate either themselves or someone else may be selected to review and score RAC grant applications, which encourages community involvement and adds relevance and resonance to the process. Follow the link in the QR code on the left, then complete and submit the form to nominate yourself or someone else as a grant reviewer.

### Introduction

Reviewers are selected based on the number and type of applications received, so you may or may not be called for service during the 2024 grant cycle. If you are not selected to be a grant reviewer during this cycle, you will be added to RAC's reviewer pool and may be contacted for future opportunities. ### Time Commitment

The time commitment required to serve depends on the number of applications and the number of reviewers.

#### **Selected reviewers are required to:**

- Sign a Confirmation Form and a Conflict-of-Interest Form.
- Attend a 1-hour virtual Reviewer Orientation.
- Attend a 1.5-hour virtual Bias/Cultural Competency Training.
- Read and rate all assigned applications.
  - Reviews are done through our online grantmaking system (Blackbaud).
  - Application reviews can be completed any time before the review deadline.
  - **Organizational Grant Application Reviewers**  
(Unrestricted Funding for Arts Organizations):  
15–40 applications (when split per category and tier)
  - **Program Support Grant Application Reviewers**  
(Art Program Funding for Non-Arts Organizations, including University Arts Programs and Fiscally Sponsored Projects):  
5–40 applications
  - **Artist Support Grant Application Reviewers**  
(Individual Artists and Artist Collaboratives/Co-Creators):  
5–40 applications (when split per discipline)
  - Expect to spend from 30-60 minutes per application.
- **For Organizational Grant Reviewers ONLY**  
In addition to the online review, reviewers may need to attend a 90-minute virtual Panel Meeting to discuss and provide a second rating for applications with the greatest score variance. All virtual meetings will be recorded and published on the website so that applicants may listen to their application's review.

#### **Eligible reviewers receive an honorarium of \$200.**

*This is a demonstration of RAC's acknowledgement of and appreciation for the time and effort invested in our arts community. Reviewers who do not meet the deadline can receive an extension but do not receive the honorarium.*
